



Georg Grün is considered to be one of the most sought-after international choral conductors and specialists for choral sound. He founded the KammerChor Saarbrücken in 1990 and has been its artistic director ever since then. He has won the most important international and national choir competitions, he gives concerts at numerous renowned music festivals and he regularly produces CDs with Saarländischer Rundfunk, Carus and Rondeau Productions. From 2000 until 2013 he held a professorship for choral conducting at the University of Music and Performing Arts Mannheim. There, he founded a chamber choir with which he also won several international prizes.

In 2012, Georg Grün changed to the University of Music Saar as a professor and became artistic director of the BachChor Saarbrücken.

Since 2008 he has been a baritone member of Daarler Vocal Consort.

Georg Grün works as guest conductor and guest professor, juror and tutor at international masterclasses for choral conducting around the world.

Since 2010 he has been a mentor at the forum for conductors of the German Music Council and since 2015, he has been Chairman at the jury of the International Chamber Choir Competition Marktoberdorf since 2015.

He is increasingly concerned with improvisation (piano / organ) and performance and is also active as a composer and arranger.

The 2017-18 season of concerts, lectures, master classes and guest performances will take him to France, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Switzerland, Spain and the United States.
